- 2) Candidate must be available to attend both the Fall 2016 (August 21-26) and Spring 2017 (March 5-10) sessions of the 2-part Leadership 2.0 Program.
- 3) Candidate must agree in advance to be responsible for travel costs to and from the sessions sites, Midland, MI (Fall) and Raleigh, NC (Spring) and for lodging.
- 4) Candidate must fully complete the scholarship application and submit it to their participating State trade association no later than June 24, 2016.
