Today we all face challenges and issues like none other ever before. Your association is here to support you in any way we possibly can. I will keep this note short and to the point.


**In an effort to support those members experiencing cash flow issues, AAASEBF Chairman Danny Durbin, with the cooperation of Blue Cross and Blue Shield of Alabama, is pleased to announce the time frame for payment of each member's monthly premium has been extended.** The standard due by the 10<sup>th</sup> and late on the 15<sup>th</sup> is changed to due by the 22<sup>nd</sup> and late thereafter. There will be no late fees assessed and members participating in both the AAASEBF and the association work comp program will be eligible for the 2% discount on the health premium if paid by the 22<sup>nd</sup>. Late notices will go out on the 22<sup>nd</sup> with late fees and will not include the multi policy discount. Chairman Durbin stated, "We truly wish we could do more, but the insurance premiums must be paid. Maintaining coverage during these unprecedented times, facing the health risks that we do, is more important than ever. We are most appreciative to Blue Cross for working with us on extending the time frames."

This announcement is for the month of April only. Rest assured, we are monitoring the situation closely and will be working to find more ways to be of assistance and support for you. You will receive notice the first part of May if the situation calls for and we are able to repeat the payment time frames along with any other developments.
